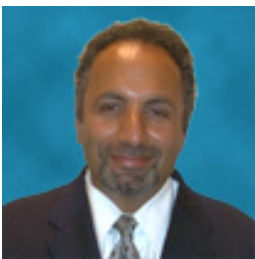


Can there be justice and peace in the Middle East? A debate at SFSU.
