Professor Barry Rubin is director of the Global Research in International Affairs (GLORIA) Center in Herzliya, Israel and a professor at the Interdisciplinary University. He is editor of the *Middle East Review of International Affairs* (MERIA) *Journal* and of *Turkish Studies* journal. During 2005-2006 he was Seymour & Lillian Abensohn Visiting Professor in Israel Studies at The American University. He writes the Middle East column for the *Jerusalem Post* and an international affairs column for the *Turkish Daily News*.

Professor Rubin's books include: *The Long War for Freedom: The Arab Struggle for Democracy in the Middle East*; *Hating America: A History*; *Yasir Arafat: A Political Biography*; *The Tragedy of the Middle East*; *The Transformation of Palestinian Politics*; *Revolution Until Victory: The Politics and History of the PLO*; *Cauldron of Turmoil: America in the Middle East*; *Istanbul Intrigues*; *Modern Dictators*; *Secrets of State: The State Department and the Struggle over U.S. Foreign Policy*; *Paved with Good Intentions: The American Experience and Iran*; *The Arab States and the Palestine Conflict*; *Islamic Fundamentalism in Egyptian Politics*; *The Great Powers in the Middle East, 1941-1947*; *Assimilation and Its Discontents*; *International News and the American Media and How Others Report Us*.

His articles have appeared in *The New York Times*, *Washington Post*, *Wall Street Journal*, *Los Angeles Times*, *Foreign Affairs*, *Foreign Policy*, *Journal of Democracy*, *Middle East Quarterly*, *The National Interest*, *The Washington Quarterly*, *The New Republic*, and many other publications. Prof. Rubin has been on "Nightline," "Face the Nation," "The David Brinkley Show," "CBS News," "The MacNeil-Lehrer NewsHour," "The Larry King Show," CNN, Fox News, and MSNBC. Among the newspapers around the world for which he has written are *La Vanguardia* in Spain, the *Frankfurter Zeitung* in Germany; the *National Post*, *Globe and Mail* in Canada; *La Opinion*, *Liberal Forum*, and *Limes* in Italy; *The Age*, *The Australian*, the *Sydney Morning Herald*, and the *Australian Financial Review* in Australia; and *Zaman*, *Referens*, and *Radikal* in Turkey.
