Phi Alpha Theta has, as its primary purpose, the recognition of exemplary work by college and university history students. The organization is also a professional society whose mission is "to promote the study of history through the encouragement of research, good teaching, publication, and the exchange of learning and ideas among historians." Membership in Phi Alpha Theta should be listed among other academic honors when applying to graduate or professional schools or when applying for employment in a history-related field.

To qualify for membership according to the criteria established by our local chapter (which are higher than those established by the national council) undergraduate students must

- have competed at least 60 semester units toward the B.A. degree
- have at least 12 semester hours in history with a grade point average better than 3.5 in all history courses
- have a GPA of 3.0 overall.

Graduate students must

- have completed 12 semester hours toward the Master's degree
- have a grade point average of 3.5 in the master's program.

Applications are accepted during the spring semester and are DUE March 21, 2011.
