The prize, including two cash awards of \$100.00 (one to an undergraduate student, one to a graduate student), is named in honor of Louis Wasserman, a former professor in the Department. The winner of the scholarship will be honored at the Political Science Department Graduation and Awards Ceremony on Tuesday May 19, 2009.
